Next steps and Q&A

Planning:

- Formal approval of programme is expected **end of October / beginning of November**
- Constituent meeting of Monitoring Committee on **23 November 2022**
- Constituent meeting of Steering Committee foreseen in **December**
- Launch of first call for proposals in **February 2023**
- Publication of call calendar for first two years of implementation

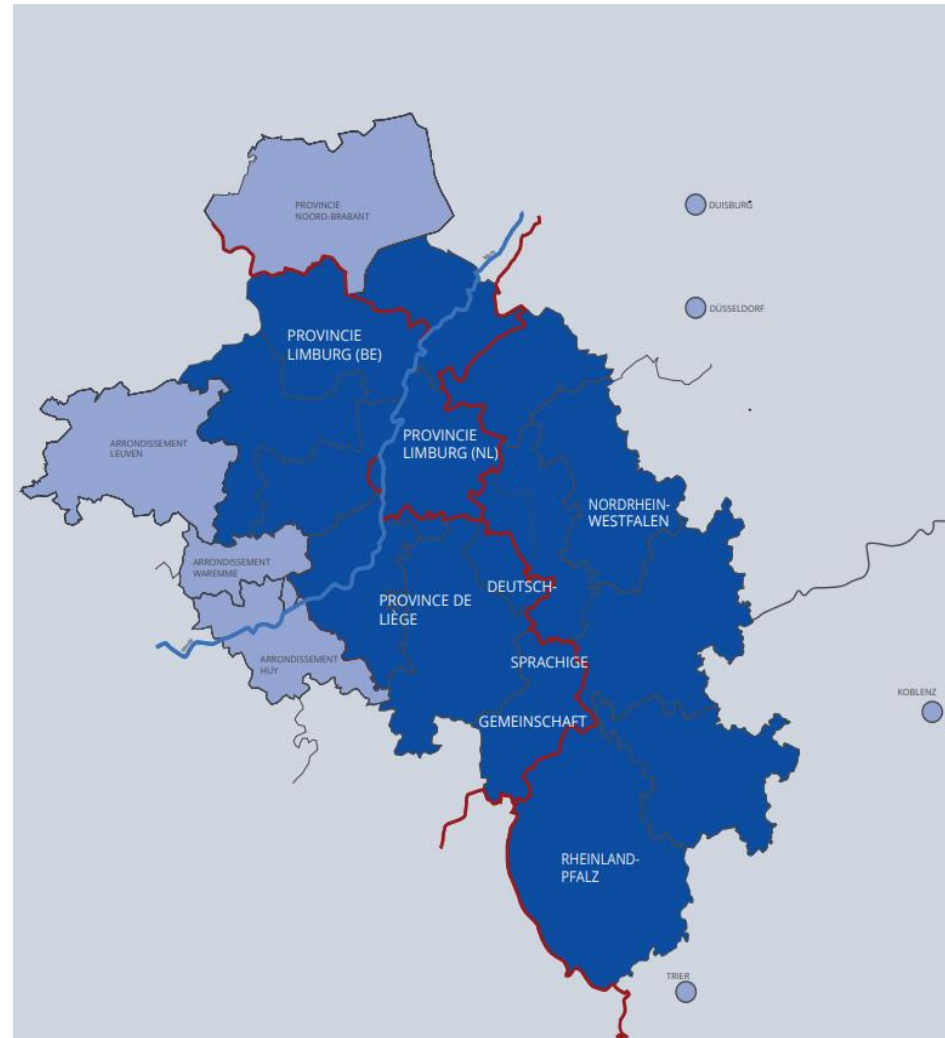

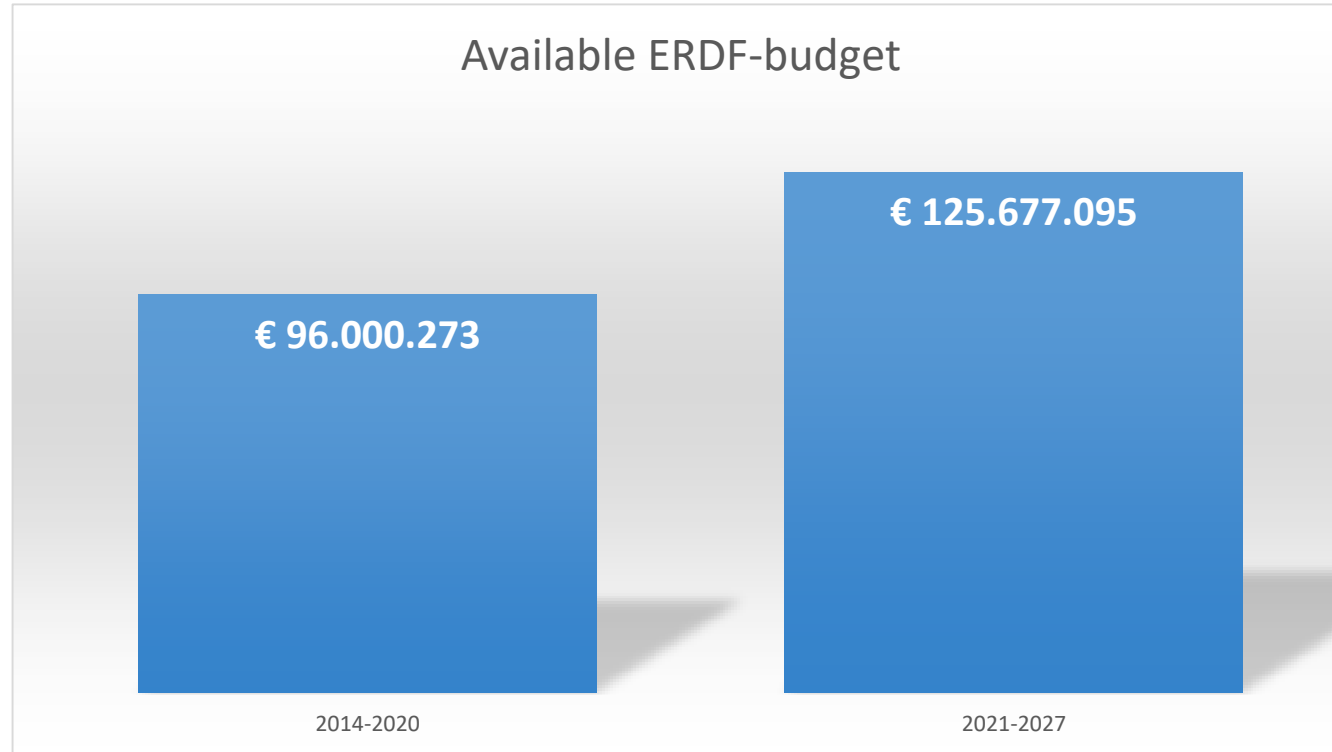

Next steps and Q&A

Budget:

- Almost 31% extra budget
- 50% ERDF for projects



Next steps and Q&A

Application and selection procedure:

- Call for proposals as application procedure
- Digital two-step procedure (step 1 consisting of short outline application to validate pertinence of the proposal with regard to programme objectives, step 2 to produce full application)
- Clear „go“ / „no go“ after step 1
- Shorter duration of total procedure
- More focus on quality and guidance during application procedure

Next steps and Q&A

Simplification of administrative procedures in development:

- New monitoring system JEMS
- Simplified cost options
- Management verifications on content and financial progress, instead of 100% financial checks

Next steps and Q&A

Clear demarcation of roles:

- Regional Antennas to provide active guidance in order to generate a sufficient flow of high-quality projects
- MA/JS is responsible for process after submission of applications until project closure
- Steering Committee for selection of operations, Monitoring Committee for supervising implementation of programme
